
Important Dates

Welcome to a new year of Webelos Walk. As always, I am so excited to invite all Webelos to participate in classes to help them earn their Webelos Pins. We will offer at least 12 different pins for you to choose from.

We will have classes from starting at 9:00am and 1:00pm on Saturday and 9:00am on Sunday. You can start registering for classes on December 1st by logging into Doubleknot.

Come join us at Merit Badge Midway at Expo on April 22 and 23rd.

Merit Badge Midway is gearing up for another fabulous year of Expo 2017. This year we are offering over 100 classes on Saturday and 50 classes on Sunday. Fees per class will be \$7.50 for 2 hours, \$10.00 for 3 hours and \$15.00 for 4 hours for signups from Dec 1 to Mar 27. Classes signed up beginning Mar 28 will cost \$15.00 for 2 hours, \$20.00 for 3 hours and \$30.00 for 4 hours up to April 14 (when online registration is no longer available). On site, April 21-23 walk ups will cost \$30.00 for 2 hours, \$30.00 for 3 hours and \$45.00 for 4 hours per class. Some classes require more materials and are priced accordingly. Please sign up early to avoid late fees.

Once again we will have 13 Independent merit badges that scouts can work on their own and then show the work to a counselor at Expo for completion.

Online registration begins on December 1, make sure to check prerequisites for classes. Scouts are encouraged to read the merit badge book before attending the classes.

Please tell all your troops at Roundtable or other events to encourage everyone to sign up before April.

Mega Mudder


The Mega Mudder is BACK!! Be prepared for an exciting, team building adventure on Saturday, April 22, 2017 at Floyd Lamb Park!
