Product of the: Las Vegas Area Council. BSA and the Nebagamon Lodge, Order of the Arrow This Camp Guide was originally compiled in 2018 for Scout Units in the Las Vegas Area Council. It showed information about Scout Camps at that time. One camp, Rancho Alegre was listed but was closed due to a devastating fire that had burned through the area. Since then, several other Camps have suffered fires, others were shut down due to low attendance, others for various reasons. Some are undergoing cleanup and will reopen. Others are closed for an indeterminant time. Subsequent Guides will add them back as they reopen. Among those camps are: Fleischmann, Kern, Kimball Scout Reservation, Lawton, Mataguay Scout Ranch, Pico Blanco, Rancho Alegre, and Raymond, among others.

This Guide is a listing of Scout Camps, contact information, and some major details. For detailed information, go to the website of the camp. Use this Guide as a Starting place. I tried to include camps within a 10-hour drive of the Las Vegas Area Council office. I made one or two exceptions for some popular camps that were given to me. I double checked information just before finalizing, and eliminated camps that were already full for the 2022. I'll include the in subsequent Guides.

All links are live in the PDF file. For links in the printed format, search the Camp name to find information.

COVID INFO: All Camps are following some sort of Covid protocols. Many require a negative test before attending camp. Masks are required in certain indoor places around camp. In some cases masks are to be worn everywhere, some in closed areas. All camps have some restrictions at the creation of this guide. Check with the camp page or Leader Guide for specifics.
